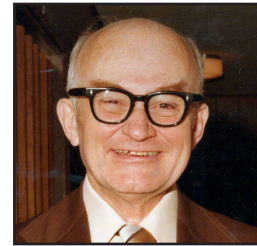


The McCauley-Rice Memorial Folk Dance Scholarship

McCauley-Rice Folk Dance Scholars have enriched the local folkdance community since 1979. Nearly 40 dancers have attended camps at Stockton and Mendocino, or have attended *balkanalia!* in Portland on these scholarships and have returned to share what they have learned in Oregon and around the Pacific Northwest and beyond.

We are offering a full scholarship to *balkanalia!* (balkanalia.org) and a \$600 scholarship to **Stockton Folk Dance Camp** (folkdancecamp.org) this summer.

Recipients are expected to share the dances they have learned with Hoolyeh dancers during the following year.
